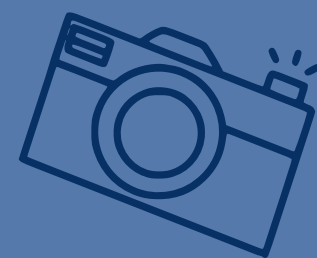

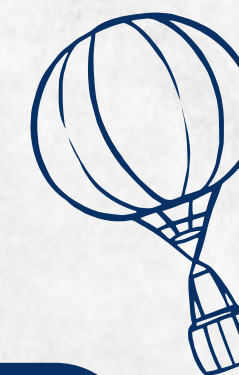

# THE TOUR OF ARLES



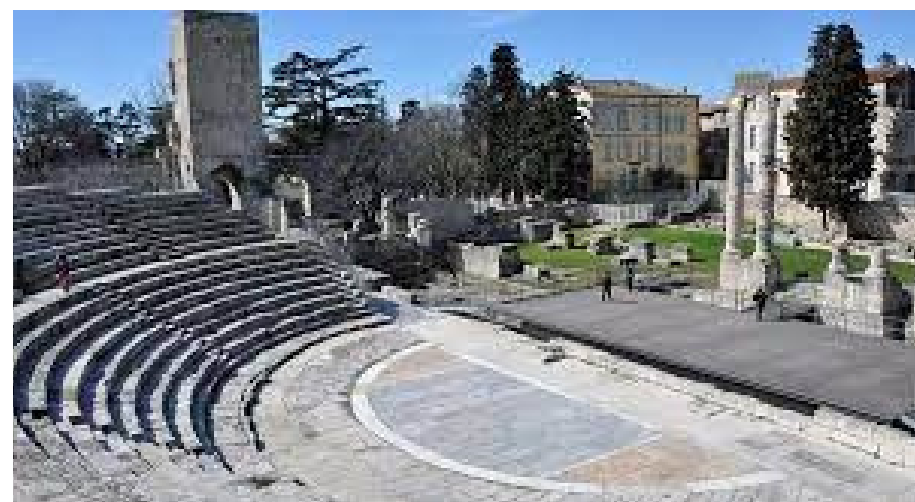
## Arènes

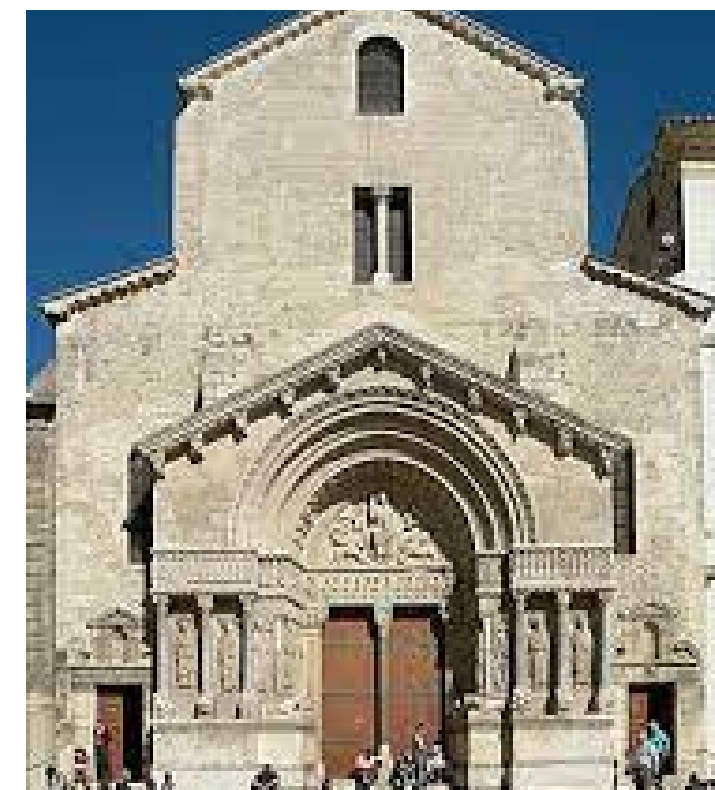
## Théâtre antique



Right next to the Arena, visit this beautifully preserved Roman theater. It is still used for performances during the summer.

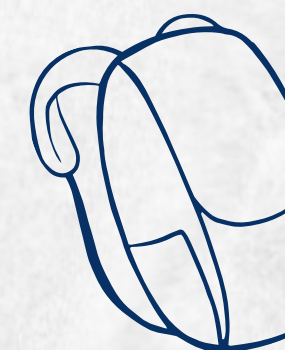

## Fondation Vincent van Gogh

This contemporary art museum is housed in an 18th-century former convent. Explore the works of renowned artists.

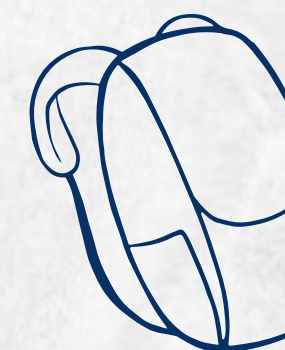

## Les Arènes

## Maison Carré



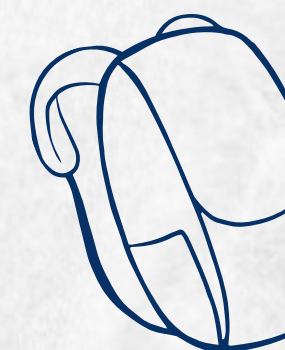
Visit this well-preserved Roman temple, located in the heart of the city. Inside, you will find an interpretation center that tells the story of Nîmes throughout the centuries.

## Jardin de la Fontaine



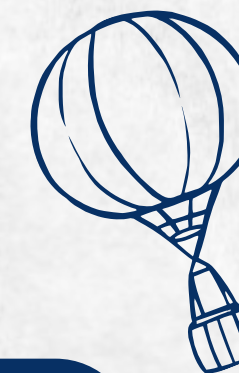
Relax in this beautiful public park located near the Maison Carrée. Here, you can discover Roman ruins, beautiful fountains, and stunning panoramic views.

## Temple de Diane



Explore this Roman temple located in the Fountain Park. It is one of the rare remnants of the original temple dedicated to Diana, the Roman goddess of the hunt

Climb up to the Magne Tower, the tallest tower of the ancient Roman fortifications in Nîmes. You'll be rewarded with a panoramic view of the city.

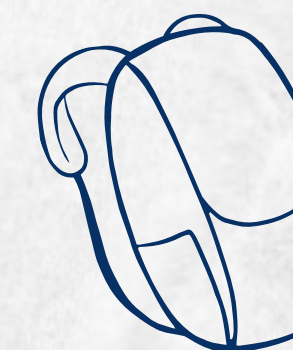

## Carrières de Lumière

Explore the Château des Baux, a medieval fortress that offers stunning panoramic views of Provence. You'll discover the history of the castle through exhibitions and demonstrations.

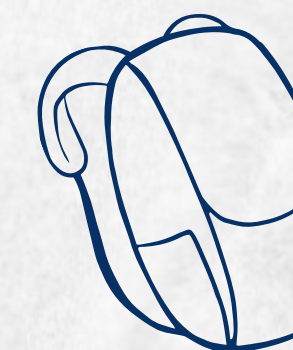

This medieval abbey, located a few kilometers from Arles, is a UNESCO World Heritage site. Explore the ruins and admire the Romanesque architecture

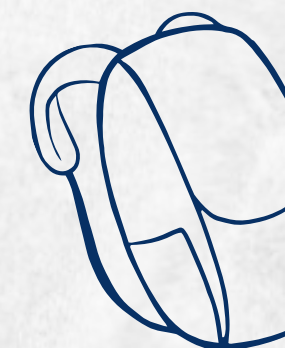

This modern and fascinating museum will help you gain a better understanding of the history and culture of the Mediterranean region. Additionally, the architecture of the building is impressive.

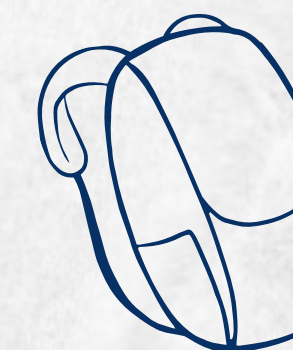
